SENATE ACT 34-16

TO APPROPRIATE FUNDING FOR ASUH NECESSITIES DRIVE AND MIXER

BE IT ENACTED BY THE UNDERGRADUATE STUDENT SENATE:

SECTION I. PURPOSE

ASUH would like to host an event in which students come together to donate to those less fortunate. Similar to Mahalo Manoa, this event will involve a week long necessities drive, followed by a mixer at the end of the week. The mixer will be held in the Campus Center Courtyard on March 11, 2016 from 4:00pm-8:00pm and will be St. Patty’s Day themed. All donations collected at the drive will be donated to Helping Hands Hawaii, Community House. The purpose of this bill is to appropriate funding for ASUH’s Necessities Drive and Mixer.

SECTION II. APPROPRIATIONS

A total of \$3,750.00 shall be appropriated from Senate Account 3325232 (University Programs, Services, and Support).

SECTION VI. This act shall take effect upon approval by the Senate.
