SENATE ACT 34-18

TO APPROPRIATE FUNDING FOR COLLEGE MENTAL HEALTH LUNCHEON

BE IT ENACTED BY THE UNDERGRADUATE STUDENT SENATE:

SECTION I. PURPOSE

In recent years, the subject of mental health has been acknowledged as a key issue on college campuses, both locally and nationally. The purpose of this bill is to fund an informal luncheon on April 20th from 12:00 pm to 1:00 pm in the Campus Center Executive Dining Room to discuss mental health and wellness among college students and to recognize the services and resources available to all students. This luncheon is part of a week-long series of events to celebrate UH-Mānoa Mental Health & Wellness Week from April 16 – 20, 2018, which was proclaimed by Governor David Ige in March 2017. UH-Mānoa Mental Health & Wellness Week is being coordinated by the Counseling & Student Development Center in collaboration with several other student organizations who are supportive of mental health initiatives around campus. This luncheon will be a culminating event and help display our solidarity with their efforts and commitment to students.

SECTION II. APPROPRIATIONS

A total of \$600.00 shall be appropriated from Senate Account 3325232 (University Programs, Services, and Support.)

SECTION IV. Any unexpected or unencumbered balance of any appropriations of this act as of the close of business on May 2, 2018 shall lapse into Senate Account 3325222.

SECTION V. The Treasurer is authorized to draw upon said account.

SECTION VI. This act shall take effect upon approval.
