SENATE ACT 28-18

FUNDING FOR THE 43RD ALBERT TESTER SYMPOSIUM
BE IT ENACTED BY THE UNDERGRADUATE STUDENT SENATE:

SECTION I. PURPOSE

The purpose of this bill is to fund for the 43rd annual Albert Tester Symposium. This event is sponsored by the Department of Biology and is open to all undergraduate and graduate students to present their research. The Tester Symposium is an event where both undergraduate and graduate students can present their research with either an oral presentation or a poster presentation. Historically, there have been approximately 20-30 undergraduate students presenting at the symposium each year, and approximately a total of 200 attendees per day, majority of whom were undergraduate students. The symposium is an opportunity for students to develop their professional skills and network with others at the university who are involved in research.

SECTION II. APPROPRIATIONS

A total of \$2,000.00 shall be appropriated from Senate Account 3325232 (University Programs, Services, and Support).

SECTION III. PROVISIONS

In accordance to the ASUH Senate Rule 27-1(h), the non-ASUH organization that may be funded is required to submit a follow up report on the proposed event or program. The follow up report shall include information regarding finances if any appropriations had been made in this measure to said organization. ASUH shall be recognized as co-funding the events and on all advertising with the phrase “partially funded by ASUH.” Partially funding of said events shall not constitute co-sponsorship by ASUH. ASUH neither implies nor accepts any liability as a result of partially funding said events.

SECTION IV. Any unexpected or unencumbered balance of any appropriation of this act as of the close of business on May 02, 2018 shall lapse into Senate Account 3325232.

SECTION V. The Treasurer is authorized to draw upon said account.

SECTION IV. This act shall take effect upon approval by the Senate, pending on the approval of the ASUH Budget by all required signatories.
