SENATE ACT 02-25

TO ALLOCATE FUNDING FOR TWO U-PASS TOWN HALL MEETINGS

BE IT ENACTED BY THE UNDERGRADUATE STUDENT SENATE:

SECTION I. PURPOSE

The purpose of this bill is to allocate funding for refreshments and lei for the upcoming town hall meetings on September 17 and 18, 2024 regarding the U-Pass program. The meetings will be in the late afternoon, a time where most students will be getting off of class or finishing work and may need something light to hold them over before dinner. Snacks and drinks will be purchased and distributed to meeting attendees, while supplies last. Additionally, City representatives will be presenting at these meetings and lei will be provided to those serving as presenters while they are being introduced.

SECTION II. APPROPRIATIONS

A total of \$600.00 shall be appropriated from Senate Account #3325232 (University Programs, Services and Support).
