BE IT ENACTED BY THE UNDERGRADUATE STUDENT SENATE:

SECTION I. PURPOSE

To allocate funding for a movie night celebration on November 4, for Lā Kū'oko'a. The short-films being shown will feature Kanaka 'Ōiwi stories and artistry, to both showcase different parts of Hawaiian history and culture, while supporting Kanaka 'Ōiwi artists of today.
