SENATE ACT 08-23

TO APPROPRIATE A CLEAN WATER ACCESS AND RED HILL TOWN HALL

BE IT ENACTED BY THE UNDERGRADUATE STUDENT SENATE:

SECTION I. PURPOSE

To fund a clean water access and Red Hill Townhall. ASUH will invite civic leaders outlining community solutions to protect access to clean water and safeguard public health and wellbeing. Currently community concerns revolve around Oʻahu's water systems being affected by the Red Hill Crisis which has displaced families to hotels throughout Oʻahu and monitoring wells have detected levels of TPH-d in water samples. Military families have undergone medical treatments due to long-term side effects of petroleum contaminant exposure in tap water. The Halawa shaft aquifer (pumping significant water supply to Honolulu) has been shut off to prevent Red Hill water flow to additional Board of Water Supply wells. Overall, three water sources are turned off which creates additional woes about deficits for water consumption including potential drought conditions from November 2022 till Spring 2023. Event will take place in the Campus Center Ballroom, Fall 2022.

SECTION II. <u>APPROPRIATIONS</u>
