#### 2. Constitutional Amendment Ballot

At the same time, decisions that we make not only affect full time students, but it affects part time students too. For us to represent part-time students in a meaningful way to administration, is for us to change our constitution which requires us to get at least 10% of the student body to vote on the question. We are also doing Amazon gift card giveaways to be raffled for those who vote in it. The last day to vote in this ballot will be April 27.

#### 3. Campus Fees
