To Appropriate Funding for Leadership Development Training: Collaboration & Engagement

BE IT ENACTED BY THE UNDERGRADUATE STUDENT SENATE:

SECTION I. PURPOSE

ASUH provides leadership training opportunities to better equip participants skills to fulfill their roles short-term and long-term. The training is facilitated by Jamie Champagne through an Outreach College course, titled ‘Collaboration & Engagement: Wherever your teams are’ beginning 8:30am-4:30pm on 10/28/22. Some components taught are critical thinking skills when interacting in a diverse workplace, project management philosophies, and personalizing collaboration methods. The session accommodates a maximum of 30 learners.

SECTION II. APPROPRIATIONS

A total of \$2,749.00 shall be appropriated from Senate Account #3325222 (Travel and workshops).

In the likelihood of more than 30 interested participants, then a waitlist will be established. Considerations for uncontested slots will go to other UHM CSO members. The VP will provide a registration roster to UHMOC, and book a reservation.

SECTION IV. Any unexpended and unencumbered balance of any appropriation of this Act, as of the close of business on May 6, 2022 shall lapse into Senate Account #3325222.

SECTION V. The Treasurer is authorized to draw upon said account.
