TO APPROPRIATE FUNDING FOR AN ADVERTISEMENT IN UH MĀNOA'S 11TH ANNUAL OFFICIAL VISITOR GUIDE

BE IT ENACTED BY THE UNDERGRADUATE STUDENT SENATE:

SECTION I. PURPOSE

The purpose of this bill is to appropriate funding for an ad in the UH Mānoa's Official Visitor's Guide. The ad is published annually and distributed year-round. The visitor's guide brings great impact to the promotion of ASUH as it is one of the university's primary print marketing tools. The total readership of the visitor's guide, which includes the print magazine, website, and mobile web app, is approximately 120,000. This will be the eleventh annual edition of the guide and will help attract new students while educating incoming and returning students about the local community and the campus environment. The visitor's guide will be distributed at various UH Manoa events and locations (e.g. recruitment fairs, school visits, orientations, bookstore, and student services offices). The visitor's guide will reach new, continuing, and prospective students, parents, faculty/staff, and other campus visitors. To increase visibility and name recognition, the Associated Students of the University of Hawai'i at Manoa (ASUH) will be purchasing a full-page advertisement in the annual visitors guide. This ad describes the mission of ASUH and summarizes some of the Senate's most recent and past initiatives. The money appropriated with this bill will pay Campus Publishers for the inclusion of an ASUH full-page advertisement. Print circulation of the guide is 30,000 units. The distribution period is from November 2020 through November 2021.

SECTION II. APPROPRIATIONS

A total of \$2,600.00 shall be appropriated from Senate Account #3325232 (University Programs, Services and Support).
